It was a hazy, hot and humid but enjoyable morning for the weekly walking group who are shown here walking the trail at Carruthers Marsh heading towards Whitby.




Lots of people were out enjoying Breakfast at Kathryn's on July 17th:

One spry and very quick elderly gentleman answered, 'They send us on bus tours.'


